PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 139-2025-PCM,<sup>1</sup> issued on 6 December 2025, a state of emergency has been declared for a period of 60 calendar days, from 7 December 2025, in the Provinces of Putumayo and Mariscal Ramón Castilla, Department of Loreto.
- The Supreme Decree was adopted to address the actions of hostile groups and other related threats, and to strengthen control of migration and borders. As a result, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, liberty of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, enshrined in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Constitution of Peru, and in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.
