INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS  
NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 018-2026-PCM,<sup>1</sup> issued on 4 February 2026, the state of emergency in various border districts of the Departments of Amazonas, Cajamarca, Madre de Dios, Piura, Puno and Ucayali has been extended for a period of 60 calendar days, from 5 February 2026. Specifically, the measure applies to:
  - The border Districts of El Cenepa and Río Santiago, Province of Condorcanqui, and the District of Imaza, Province of Bagua, in the Department of Amazonas;
  - The District of Namballe, Province of San Ignacio, Department of Cajamarca;
  - The Districts of Iberia, Tahuamanu and Iñapari, Province of Tahuamanu, Department of Madre de Dios;
  - The District of Lancones, Province of Sullana, and the Districts of Suyo and Ayabaca, Province of Ayabaca, in the Department of Piura;
  - The Districts of San Juan del Oro and Yanahuaya, Province of Sandia; the Districts of Sina and Ananea, Province of San Antonio de Putina; the District of Cojata, Province of Huancané; the Districts of Huayrapata, Moho and Tilali, Province of Moho; the Districts of Yunguyo, Tinicachi and Ollaraya, Province of Yunguyo; the Districts of Desaguadero, Kelluyo and Pisacoma, Province of Chucuito; and the District of Capazo, Province of El Collao, in the Department of Puno; and

- The District of Masisea, Province of Coronel Portillo; the District of Yurua, Province of Atalaya; and the District of Purús, Province of Purús, in the Department of Ucayali.
- This measure was adopted to address crime and other situations of violence, and to strengthen control over migration and borders. As a result, the exercise of the constitutional rights relating to the inviolability of the home, liberty of movement in the national territory, freedom of assembly, and liberty and security of person, enshrined in paragraphs 9, 11, 12 and 24 (f) of article 2 of the Constitution of Peru and in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is restricted.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations takes this opportunity to convey to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
