QATAR: DECLARATION ¹ OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE OBLIGATIONS CONTAINED IN THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED NATIONS

4th September 1971

Your Excellency,

I have the honour, on behalf of the Government of Qatar, to inform you that the State of Qatar, having resumed full international responsibility as a sovereign and independent State on the third of September 1971, wishes herewith to make application to be admitted to the United Nations Organization.

I should be grateful if you would arrange for this application to be placed before the Security Council and the General Assembly at their next meetings.

My Government endorses the purposes and principles stated in the United Nations Charter and declares that it accepts the obligations incumbent upon Members of the Organization and solemnly undertakes to fulfil them.

Please accept, Your Excellency, the assurances of my high consideration.
