No. 1168. STATUTE OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE. SIGNED AT LONDON
ON 5 MAY 1949¹

AMENDMENT to article 26 fixing at two the number of representatives of Liechtenstein in the Consultative Assembly

The amendment was approved by the Consultative Assembly of the Council of Europe on 28 September 1978, and by the Committee of Ministers of the said Council on 13 November 1978. It came into force on 27 November 1978, the date of the certificate drawn up by the Secretary-General of the Council to certify approval, in accordance with article 41 of the Statute of the Council of Europe.
