No. 186. PROTOCOL SIGNED AT LAKE SUCCESS, NEW YORK, ON 11 DECEMBER 1946,<sup>1</sup> AMENDING THE AGREEMENTS, CONVENTIONS AND PROTOCOLS ON NARCOTIC DRUGS CONCLUDED AT THE HAGUE ON 23 JANUARY 1912,<sup>2</sup> AT GENEVA ON 11 FEBRUARY 1925 AND 19 FEBRUARY 1925, AND 13 JULY 1931, AT BANGKOK ON 27 NOVEMBER 1931 AND AT GENEVA ON 26 JUNE 1936

ACCESSION to the Convention for the Suppression of the Illicit Traffic in Dangerous Drugs signed at Geneva on 26 June 1936<sup>3</sup> and amended by the above-mentioned Protocol of 11 December 1946<sup>1</sup>

Although the Protocol of 11 December 1946 does not formally amend the 1912 Convention, it provides in its article III:

"The functions conferred upon the Netherlands Government under articles 21 [to] 25 of the International Opium Convention signed at The Hague on 23 January 1912, and entrusted to the Secretary-General of the League of Nations, with the consent of the Netherlands Government by a resolution of the League of Nations Assembly dated 15 December 1920, shall henceforward be exercised by the Secretary-General of the United Nations."

Actions relating to the Convention of 1912 as amended in effect by the above provision are registered in the same way as actions relating to the Conventions as formally amended by the Protocol of 1946, namely under No. 186 in part I originally assigned to the latter Protocol; for such actions see references in Cumulative Indexes Nos. 1 to 8, 10 and 12.
