CONVENTION¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FRENCH
REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF MAURITIUS ON THE
DELIMITATION OF THE FRENCH AND MAURITIAN ECO-
NOMIC ZONES BETWEEN THE ISLANDS OF RÉUNION AND
MAURITIUS

The Government of the French Republic and
The Government of Mauritius,

Wishing to strengthen their good-neighbourly relations and establish closer ties
of friendship between the two countries,

Wishing to effect the delimitation of the French economic zone and the Mauritian
economic zone between the islands of Réunion and Mauritius,

Taking into account the work of the Third United Nations Conference on the
Law of the Sea and the relevant principles of international law,

Considering that the equidistance method would provide an equitable means of
effecting delimitation in this case,

Referring to the statement of conclusions signed at Port Louis on 17 May 1979
by the representatives of the two countries,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1. The line of delimitation between the economic zone of the French
Republic and the economic zone of Mauritius, between the islands of Réunion and
Mauritius, shall follow the median line defined in article 2 below.

Article 2. (1) The line specified in article 1 above shall be defined by joining
points P1, P2, P3, P4, P5, P6 and P7, whose geographical co-ordinates are specified
in annex I.

(2) The said line is drawn on the map in annex II.²

(3) Annexes I and II are integral parts of this Convention.

Article 3. This Convention shall enter into force on the date of its signature.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the representatives of the two Governments, duly authorized
to that effect, have signed this Convention and affixed their seals thereto.
