No. 8940. EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY ROAD (ADR). DONE AT GENEVA, ON 30 SEPTEMBER 19571

ENTRY INTO FORCE of amendments to annex B, as amended,2 of the above-mentioned Agreement.

The amendments were proposed by the Government of France and circulated by the Secretary-General on 2 December 1981. They came into force on 2 June 1982, in accordance with article 14 (3) of the Agreement.

## ANNEX I

## AMENDMENTS TO THE ADR ADOPTED BY THE GROUP OF EXPERTS

#### GENERAL AMENDMENTS

Marginal 52 121 (2) should be amended to read as follows:

"(2) Substances of 10°, 14° and 15° may also be carried in tank-containers."

Marginal 10 182 should be amended to read:

"(1) Tank-vehicles, vehicles with demountable tanks and carrying vehicles of tank-containers and, where so required under the provisions of chapter II of this annex, other vehicles shall be subject to technical inspection in their country of registration to make sure that they conform to the provisions of this annex, including those of its appendices, and to the general safety regulations (concerning brakes, lighting, etc.) in force in their country of registration; if these vehicles are trailers or semi-trailers coupled behind a drawing vehicle, the drawing vehicle shall be subject to technical inspection for the same purposes."

"(2) ... (3) ...".

"(4) The validity of special approval certificate shall expire not later than one year after the date of the technical inspection of the vehicle preceding the issue of the certificate. However, in the case of tanks subject to compulsory periodic inspection this provision shall not have the result of requiring tightness (leakproofness) tests, hydraulic pressure tests or internal inspections of tanks to be carried out at intervals shorter than those laid down in appendices B.1a and B.1c."

# Marginal 11 401

Paragraph 2(b) should be amended to read as follows:

"Not more than 500 kgs of substances of  $1^{\circ}$ — $10^{\circ}$  and  $12^{\circ}$ , class 1a, as well as articles of  $1^{\circ}$ ,  $2^{\circ}$  (a), (c) and (d),  $3^{\circ}$ ,  $6^{\circ}$ — $11^{\circ}$  of class 1b or dangerous goods, class 1c. However, substances of class 1a,  $3^{\circ}$ ,  $4^{\circ}$  and  $5^{\circ}$  must be packed in accordance with what is prescribed for consignments carried otherwise than as a complete load."

# Marginal 10 181

- (1) (b) should read:
- "(b) The driver's certificate of competence as prescribed under 10 170 and reproduced in appendix B.6."

A new Appendix B.6 should be added to the ADR as follows:\*

"Appendix B.6 (See marginal 10 181)

"The certificate of competence for drivers of vehicles carrying dangerous goods issued in conformity with the prescription in marginal 10 170 shall have the layout as reproduced in the model below. It is recommended that the format shall be the same as the European national driving permit, namely A7 (74 x 105mm) or a double sheet which can be folded to that format."
