DECLARATION concerning Aruba

1 January 1986

NETHERLANDS

(With effect from 1 January 1986. The Government of the Netherlands declared that, following the granting on 1 January 1986 of internal autonomy to Aruba, which was until then part of the Netherlands Antilles, the obligations hitherto applicable in Aruba by virtue of declarations accepting the obligations of the above-mentioned Convention in respect of the Netherlands Antilles will continue to apply in respect of Aruba.)
