

No. 21618. EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON MAIN INTERNATIONAL TRAFFIC ARTERIES (AGR). CONCLUDED AT GENEVA ON 15 NOVEMBER 1975<sup>1</sup>

ENTRY INTO FORCE of Amendments to Annex 1 of the above-mentioned Agreement

The amendments were proposed by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and circulated by the Secretary-General to the Contracting Parties on 19 April 1989. They came into force on 29 January 1990, in accordance with article 8 (5) of the Agreement.

The amendments to Annex I are as follows:

The itinerary in the territory of the Federal Republic of Germany which presently reads:

“E 431 Giessen – Frankfurt am Main – Mannheim” *should read* “E 451 Giessen – Frankfurt am Main – Mannheim”.

Introduce the following new class B road E 553 on the territory of the Federal Republic of Germany and the territory of Czechoslovakia:

“E 553 Regensburg – Cham – Furth im Wald – Plzeň”.
