

No. 7247. INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE PROTECTION OF PERFORMERS, PRODUCERS OF PHONOGRAMS AND BROADCASTING ORGANISATIONS. DONE AT ROME, ON 26 OCTOBER 1961<sup>1</sup>

PARTIAL withdrawal of reservations and modification of a reservation made upon ratification<sup>2</sup>

*Notification received on:*

10 February 1994

FINLAND

The reservations to article 6 (2) and 16 (1) (b) which have been withdrawn read as follows:

“With regard to article 6, paragraph 2: Protection will be granted to broadcasting organisations only if their headquarters is situated in another Contracting State and if their broadcasts are transmitted from a transmitter situated in the same Contracting State.

With regard to article 16, paragraph 1 (b): The provisions of article 13 (d) will be applied only to the communication to the public of television broadcasts in a cinema or other similar place.”

The reservation with regard to article 16 (1) (a) (ii) has been modified to read as follows:

“The provisions of article 12 will be applied solely with respect to broadcasting as well as to any other communication to the public which is carried out for profit-making purposes.”
