

No. 5158. CONVENTION RELATING TO THE STATUS OF STATELESS PERSONS. DONE AT NEW YORK, ON 28 SEPTEMBER 1954¹

ACCESSION

Instrument deposited on :

17 December 1962

IRELAND

(To take effect on 17 March 1963.)

With the following declaration and reservation :

DECLARATION

“The Government of Ireland understand the words public order and in accordance with due process of law, as they appear in Article 31 of the Convention, to mean respectively, public policy and in accordance with a procedure by law” ;

RESERVATION

“With regard to Article 29 (1), the Government of Ireland do not undertake to accord to stateless persons treatment more favourable than that accorded to aliens generally with respect to

“(a) the stamp duty chargeable in Ireland in connection with conveyances, transfers and leases of lands, tenements and hereditaments, and

“(b) income tax (including sur-tax).”
