

No. 4491. AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, BELGIUM, DENMARK, FRANCE, THE NETHERLANDS AND THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND RELATING TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR REGULATING THE POLICE OF THE NORTH SEA FISHERIES SIGNED AT THE HAGUE ON 6 MAY 1882.¹ SIGNED AT THE HAGUE, ON 3 JUNE 1955²

TERMINATION in respect of the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

As a result of denunciation of the above-mentioned Convention of 6 May 1882, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland will cease to be a party to the Agreement on the effective date of the said denunciation, i.e. 15 May 1964.
