- Cocoa and products having a cocoa base
- Bonbons, dragées and other products having a sugar base
- Perfumes having an alcohol base
- Patent medicines
- Beer
- Lubricating oils
- Matches
- Saccharın
- Automatic lighters and lighter flints
- Cigarette paper and tubes
- Bananas
