

No. 4214. CONVENTION ON THE INTER-GOVERNMENTAL MARITIME CONSULTATIVE ORGANIZATION. DONE AT GENEVA, ON 6 MARCH 1948¹

COMMUNICATION from the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

In a communication addressed to the Secretary-General of the United Nations on 6 August 1964, the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, recalling the declarations made on its behalf on 29 September 1961² under articles 58 (a) and 9, respectively, of the above-mentioned Convention, requested the Secretary-General, in his capacity as depositary of the Convention, to take note of the following :

“...as a result of the Agreement relating to Malaysia signed in London on July 9, 1963, and legislation enacted in accordance with that Agreement, Sarawak and North Borneo, together with the State of Singapore, federated with the existing States of the Federation of Malaya and the Federation is now called Malaysia. Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom are therefore no longer responsible for the international relations of Sarawak and North Borneo.”
