SUCCESSION by MALAWI to the above-mentioned Conventions

In a communication received on 22 July 1965, the Government of Malawi notified the Secretary-General that it considers itself bound by the above-mentioned Conventions which had been extended to the former Nyasaland Protectorate by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
