

No. 6964. TREATY BANNING NUCLEAR WEAPON TESTS IN THE ATMOSPHERE, IN OUTER SPACE AND UNDER WATER. SIGNED AT MOSCOW, ON 5 AUGUST 1963¹

* The note transmitting the instrument of ratification of the Government of Kuwait contains the following statement :

“In ratifying the said Convention, the Government of the State of Kuwait takes the view that its signature and ratification of the said Convention does not in any way imply its recognition of Israel, nor does it oblige it to apply the provisions of the Convention in respect of the said country.

“The Government of the State of Kuwait wishes further to indicate that its understanding described above is in conformity with the general practice existing in Kuwait regarding signature, ratification or accession to a Convention of which a country not recognized by Kuwait is a party.”

SUCCESSION by the GAMBIA

By a note dated 27 April 1965, the Government of the Gambia notified the Government of the United States of America that they regard themselves as continuing to be bound by the above-mentioned Treaty ratified by the British Government on 10 October 1963, at which time the latter Government were responsible for the international relations of the Gambia.

Certified statement was registered by the United States of America on 21 September 1965.
