

No. 4757. BERNE CONVENTION FOR THE PROTECTION OF LITERARY AND ARTISTIC WORKS SIGNED ON 9 SEPTEMBER 1886, COMPLETED AT PARIS ON 4 MAY 1896, REVISED AT BERLIN ON 13 NOVEMBER 1908, COMPLETED AT BERNE ON 20 MARCH 1914, REVISED AT ROME ON 2 JUNE 1928, AND REVISED AT BRUSSELS ON 26 JUNE 1948<sup>1</sup>

#### TERRITORIAL APPLICATION

Notice of the extension of the above-mentioned Convention by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the following territories was communicated by the Swiss Government to the other countries of the Union, and the Convention became applicable to those territories on the dates indicated below :
