DECLARATIONS (paragraphs 2 and 3) by the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND :

a) Application to St. Helena of the following modifications :

Article 3. The funds of a trade union may be expended only for objects specified in national laws.

This declaration supersedes the declaration registered with the Director-General of the International Labour Office on 19 June 1958.²

b) Application to Fiji of the following modifications :

Articles 2 and 3 : Excluded.

This declaration supersedes the declaration registered with the Director-General of the International Labour Office on 29 December 1958.³
