## SIGNATURE and RATIFICATION

The Convention was signed and the instrument of ratification was deposited with the Secretary-General of the Council of Europe on:

2 May 1966

IRELAND

(To take effect on 31 July 1966.)

The signature was accompanied by the following declaration (minutes of signature and deposit of 2 May 1966):

"I have the honour to declare, in accordance with Article 6 of the Convention, that the term 'national' in the Convention is hereby defined as meaning 'citizens of Ireland' as far as my Government is concerned."

The instrument of ratification contains the following reservation:

## Article 9

"The Irish Authorities will not grant extradition if final judgment in respect of the offence for which extradition is requested has been passed in a third state on the person claimed."

Certified statement was registered by the Council of Europe on 20 June 1966.
