\* In a communication received by the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization on 11 August 1967, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany declared that "the Convention and the Protocol shall also apply to the Land Berlin, with effect from the date on which the Convention and Protocol will enter into force for the Federal Republic of Germany".

In a further communication received on 4 April 1968, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany informed the Director-General that the following supplementary phrase should be added to the above-mentioned declaration : "...account being taken of the rights and responsibilities of the Allied Authorities, in particular the powers retained by them with regard to the maintenance of the security of Berlin, and notably, those in the military field."
