

No. 5158. CONVENTION RELATING TO THE STATUS OF STATELESS PERSONS. DONE AT NEW YORK ON 28 SEPTEMBER 1954¹

SUCCESSION

Notification received on :

25 February 1969

BOTSWANA

The notification reads as follows :

“ The Government of Botswana confirms that it regards itself as continuing to be bound by the said Convention to the extent that the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland was so bound in relation to the Bechuanaland Protectorate² subject, however, to the following additional reservations :

- “ (a) article 31 of the said Convention shall not oblige Botswana to grant to a stateless person a status more favourable than that accorded to aliens in general ;
- “ (b) articles 12 (1) and 7 (2) of the Convention shall be recognized as recommendations only. ”
