With the following declaration:

Following the declaration by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany concerning the application to West Berlin of the Customs Convention concerning Facilities for the Importation of Goods for Display or Use at Exhibitions, Fairs, Meetings or similar Events done at Brussels on 8th June 1961, <sup>1</sup> as set, out in the letter of the Customs Co-operation Council under date of 18th March 1969, No. 15.074, Tl-032, the Embassy of the Polish People's Republic have the honour to state, on behalf of their Government, that the Government of the Polish People's Republic reject the declaration of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany since that declaration is contrary to the international status of West Berlin which has never been and is not part of the Federal Republic of Germany.
