No. 1671. A. CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC, SIGNED AT GENEVA
ON 19 SEPTEMBER 1949¹

SUCCESSION

Notification received on:

5 March 1971

BARBADOS

(With the declaration that the Government of Barbados wished to maintain the declarations and reservations subject to which the Convention was extended to Barbados by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and which were the same as those made by that Government in its own instrument of ratification², as well as the distinctive letters "BDS" which were notified by the Government of the United Kingdom to the Secretary-General, pursuant to article 20 of the Convention³ and the provisions of its annex 4⁴, as the distinguishing sign for motor vehicles in international traffic registered in Barbados.)
