

No. 8303. AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK, DONE AT MANILA ON 4 DECEMBER 1965¹

ADMISSION to membership in the Bank

The following countries have been admitted for membership in the Bank on the dates indicated hereafter, i.e. on the dates determined by the Bank under article 3 (2) or 3 (3)* of the Agreement:

INDONESIA	24 November 1966
SWITZERLAND	31 December 1967
HONG KONG*	27 March 1969
FJI*	2 April 1970
FRANCE	27 July 1970

With the following reservation, in accordance with article 56 (2):

Pursuant to article 56 (2) of the said Agreement, the French Government retains for itself the right to levy taxes, as provided by French law, on salaries and emoluments paid by the Bank to French nationals.
