No. 1168. STATUTE OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE. SIGNED AT LONDON ON 5 MAY 1949<sup>1</sup>

AMENDMENT to article 26 of the Statute of the Council of Europe

The Amendment was approved by the Committee of Ministers at the 194th meeting of the Ministers' Deputies held from 19 to 27 November 1970, subsequently approved by the Consultative Assembly of the Council of Europe on 28 January 1971, and came into force on 17 February 1971, the date of the certificate of the Secretary-General of the Council of Europe certifying approval, as provided for by article 41 (*d*) of the Statute of the Council of Europe.

The amended text of article 26 is worded as follows:
