

No. 8638. VIENNA CONVENTION ON CONSULAR RELATIONS. DONE AT VIENNA ON 24 APRIL 1963¹

RATIFICATION

Instrument deposited on:

7 September 1971

FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY

(To take effect on 7 October 1971.)

With the following declaration:

“The said Convention and Optional Protocols shall also apply to Land Berlin with effect from the date on which they enter into force for the Federal Republic of Germany, subject to the existing rights and responsibilities of the Powers responsible for Berlin including the right to decide on the admission of heads of consular missions in their sectors and to determine the extent of consular privileges and immunities.”

OBJECTION concerning the reservations made by Egypt in respect of articles 46, 49, 62 and 65 of the above-mentioned Convention

FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY

“The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany does not regard as valid the reservations to articles 46, 49, 62 and 65 of the Convention made by the Government of the United Arab Republic.”²

“This declaration shall not be regarded as an obstacle to the entry into force of the Convention between the Federal Republic of Germany and the United Arab Republic.”
