#### ACCEPTANCE

*Instrument deposited with the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization on:*

30 December 1971

SAUDI ARABIA

(To take effect on 30 March 1972.)

With the following reservation:

“The Saudi Arabian Government accepts the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution of the Sea by Oil dated 12th May, 1954, with the reservation of Article No. 13 of the Convention which will not bind the Saudi Arabian Government until the latter finally notify their acceptance. In this case the Article will come into force two months after the aforesaid notification.”
