

No. 8959. AGREEMENT BETWEEN DENMARK, FINLAND, NORWAY AND SWEDEN CONCERNING CO-OPERATION TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS FOR PREVENTING THE POLLUTION OF THE SEA BY OIL. SIGNED AT COPENHAGEN ON 8 DECEMBER 1967¹

TERMINATION

The above-mentioned Agreement ceased to have effect on 16 October 1971, the date of entry into force of the Agreement between Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden concerning co-operation in measures to deal with pollution of the sea by oil signed at Copenhagen on 16 September 1971.²
