

No. 13561. INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SIMPLIFICATION AND HARMONIZATION OF CUSTOMS PROCEDURES. CONCLUDED AT KYOTO ON 18 MAY 1973¹

RATIFICATION

Instrument deposited with the Secretary General of the Customs Co-operation Council on:

20 October 1975

BELGIUM

(Confirming the declaration made upon signature and with a declaration, under article 11 (4), to the effect that Belgium accepts annex E.3 subject to the reservations made upon signature of the Convention. With effect from 20 January 1976.)

ENTRY INTO FORCE of annex E.5 to the above-mentioned Convention

The annex came into force on 5 November 1975, i.e. three months after five States had accepted it, in accordance with article 12(3) of the Convention.
