PELLELINES: Gas from a managed oil or gas pipeline could cause an explosion or some other serious hazard. Pipelines are not always buried and their presence may effectively reduce the charted depth by as much as 5 metres. Where pipelines are close together, only one may be shown. Mariners should not anchor or trawl in the vicinity of a pipeline they may risk prosecution if damage is caused.

TUNNY NETS: Tunny nets may be fished off the coast of Libya extending as much as five miles offshore. Mariners are warned to keep a good lookout for these nets which are generally marked by day and night, as described in Admiralty Sailing Directions.

MARINE FARMS: Marine farms exist within the area of this chart. They may not all be shown individually and their positions may change frequently. Marine farms may be marked by buoys or other structures. Mariners are advised to avoid these structures and their associated moorings.

NAVIGATIONAL AIDS: Certain lights and other navigational aids have been omitted from this chart for details of these the larger scale charts and the appropriate Admiralty publications should be consulted. No wrecks are shown on this chart.

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
