AGREEMENT ON THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS AND ON THE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR SUCH CARRIAGE (ATP)

GENEVA, 1 SEPTEMBER 1970

GERMANY: COMMUNICATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 18 (2) (B) OF THE AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 26 July 2011, the Government of Germany notified the Secretary-General, pursuant to article 18 (2) (b) of the Agreement, that although it intends to accept the proposal of amendments to the ATP transmitted by C.N.67.2011.TREATIES-1 of 11 February 2011, the conditions necessary for such acceptance are not yet fulfilled.

Consequently, in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 2 to 5 of article 18 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments to the ATP, will be deemed accepted only if, before the expiry of a period of nine months following the expiry of the period of six months as indicated in the said article (i.e., before 11 May 2012), the Government of Germany has not notified an objection to the proposed amendments.
