



***2015 Treaty Event:  
Seventy years of multilateral treaty making at the United Nations  
Daily Report***

Wednesday, 30 September 2015

Today six (6) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by five (5) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of Government** and four (4) States participated at the **ministerial level**.

There were a total two (2) accessions, two (2) ratifications, and two (2) signatures. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:
