



***2018 Treaty Event:
Promotion of Human Rights through the Multilateral Treaty Framework
Daily Report***

Wednesday, 26 September 2018

Today fifteen (15) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by thirteen (13) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of State**, two (2) States participated at the level of **Head of Government**, nine (9) States participated at the **ministerial level** and one (1) State participated at the **ambassadorial level**.

There were a total of one (1) accession, six (6) ratifications and eight (8) signatures. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:

Human Rights

- **Optional Protocol to the Convention on the Rights of the Child on a communications procedure (New York, 19 December 2011)**
(Accession by San Marino)
- **International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance (New York, 20 December 2006)**
(Signature by the Dominican Republic)

Penal Matters

- **International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism (New York, 13 April 2005)**
(Ratification by Guatemala)

Disarmament

- **Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (New York, 7 July 2017)**
(Signature by Antigua and Barbuda, Benin, Brunei Darussalam, Guinea-Bissau, Myanmar, Seychelles and Timor-Leste; Ratification by the Gambia, Samoa, San Marino and Vanuatu)

Environment

- **Paris Agreement (Paris, 12 December 2015)**
(Ratification by San Marino)
