



***2024 Treaty Event:
Strengthening the Multilateral Treaty Framework
Daily Report***

Tuesday, 24 September 2024

Today fifteen (15) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by twelve (12) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of State**; nine (9) States participated at the **ministerial level** and two (2) States participated at **other level**.

There were a total of one (1) acceptance, one (1) accession, five (5) ratifications and eight (8) signatures. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:

International Trade and Development

- **United Nations Convention on the International Effects of Judicial Sales of Ships (New York, 7 December 2022)** (Signature by Libya)

Law of the Sea

- **Agreement under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea on the Conservation and Sustainable Use of Marine Biological Diversity of Areas beyond National Jurisdiction (New York, 19 June 2023)** (Signature by Botswana, Côte d'Ivoire, Jamaica, Kenya, Liberia, and Sao Tome and Principe; Ratification by Maldives and Singapore)

Disarmament

- **Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (New York, 7 July 2017)** (Signature by Solomon Islands; Ratification by Indonesia, Sierra Leone and Solomon Islands)

Environment

- **Minamata Convention on Mercury (Kumamoto, 10 October 2013)** (Acceptance by Liberia; Accession by Maldives)
