
2024 Treaty Event: Strengthening the Multilateral Treaty Framework Daily Report

Wednesday, 25 September 2024

Today nine (9) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by seven (7) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of State**; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of Government** and five (5) States participated at the **ministerial level**.

There were a total of two (2) accessions, three (3) ratifications and four (4) signatures. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:
