



***2025 Treaty Event:
Eighty Years of Multilateral Treaty Making at the United Nations
Daily Report***

Friday, 26 September 2025

Today seven (7) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by six (6) States, which participated at the **ministerial level**.

There was a total of one (1) acceptance, two (2) accessions, three (3) ratifications and one (1) signature. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:

Disarmament

- **Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (New York, 7 July 2017)**
(Signature by Kyrgyzstan and Ratification by Ghana)

Environment

- **Convention on the Protection and Use of Transboundary Watercourses and International Lakes (Helsinki, 17 March 1992)** (Accession by Sierra Leone)
- **Amendments to Articles 25 and 26 of the Convention on the Protection and Use of Transboundary Watercourses and International Lakes (Madrid, 28 November 2003)** (Acceptance by Sierra Leone)
- **Minamata Convention on Mercury (Kumamoto, 10 October 2013)**
(Ratification by Israel)

Law of the Sea

- **Agreement under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea on the Conservation and Sustainable Use of Marine Biological Diversity of Areas beyond National Jurisdiction (New York, 19 June 2023)** (Ratification by Honduras)

Outer Space

- **Convention on registration of objects launched into outer space (New York, 12 November 1974)** (Accession by Malaysia)
